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MESSAGE FROM FOUNDER

"No more apologies for a bleeding heart when the opposite is no heart at all. Danger of losing our humanity must be met with more humanity."

This quote from Toni Morrison gave me pause recently; I was contemplating the sheer magnitude of the ways in which we need to repair the world, and the ways in which we could passively give up. The 2024 provisional data for U.S. drug overdose fatalities were recently released and showed a continued trend downward over the last 12 months. Wonderful news! Yet, we are obligated to take a closer look-- in 12 months alone from 2022-2023, we lost nearly 112,000 Americans to a drug-related fatality, whereas the more recent data shows about 99,000 for 2024. This trend is deeply encouraging but does not offer us the chance to say our work is anywhere near complete. These are still catastrophic numbers, and prior to March 2021, we would have labeled 99,000 as historic in our country. There is no room for passivity, not until that number reaches zero.

To that end, BirdieLight remains committed to our vision. Every young person should be fully educated about the current drug landscape, particularly the tools, such as fentanyl test strips and naloxone (Narcan), that are available to keep them and their peers alive.

In the past three years, our team has educated nearly 70,000 students, parents, healthcare professionals, and educators about the dangers of fentanyl, and 2025 promises to be just as busy. In honor of all who have died during this public health crisis, including my precious son Eli, we will continue to do the work that must be done.

The memoirist Sarah McColl writes that "in its persistence, grief reminds us that we are alive." Grief is certainly persistent, not only for my family, but for the countless families I have met over the past three years. A deep well of pain is the consistent thread in these stories. Pain we can't fix, but our successes have consistently been found in the offering of hope for a better future.

In the beginning, after Eli died, I worked just to remind myself that I was alive; now the BirdieLight team works tirelessly to reassure young people that their lives have immense value, deserving of the education and care we put into keeping them safe. To get this far, I recognize the immense support we have received from each of you. Please continue on this healing journey with our team; we promise you that together, we will save lives.

Our mission is to educate young people and parents about the dangers of fentanyl, empowering them with the knowledge to avoid accidental fentanyl ingestions, and therefore avoid overdose situations. We equip young people with essential tools: in-depth education, fentanyl test strips, and Narcan training, all meant to empower proactive risk management.

PROGRAM 1: FENTANYL EDUCATION EVENTS



Through this approach, we have enlightened **over 60,000 young adults** across the nation about fentanyl risk and necessary preventative measures. This year alone, we hosted 50 events, engaging with students in Ohio, Connecticut, South Carolina, Arizona, Kansas, California, Illinois, and Massachusetts. Our efforts extended beyond students to parents, educators, and healthcare professionals, delivering impactful presentations that foster understanding and raise awareness.

BirdieLight's mission is realized by ensuring that individuals ages 12-25 across America are equipped with information about the fentanyl public health crisis, in order to navigate toward safer choices. To achieve this, we create an engaging space for dialogues in various settings, such as middle schools, high schools, and college campuses, underpinned by our fentanyl education curriculum. This content is delivered through an interactive presentation: what fentanyl is, where it's found, and how to stay safe from it.



OUR EDUCATION IN ACTION

In April of 2024, BirdieLight delivered presentations to two high schools in the same Midwest region, both with similar populations and demographics, during the same week. One school had previously received our education the year before, while the other had not. Below are the results from our post-presentation surveys completed by students.

Before this presentation, did you know fentanyl is present in fake pills, such as counterfeit Xanax/Adderall/oxycodone?

Before this presentation did you know that fentanyl is present in cocaine?



Before this presentation, had you heard of fentanyl test strips?

Before this presentation, did you know where to obtain fentanyl test strips?



The results are clear: students at the previously visited school showed significantly higher awareness of fentanyl dangers and safety measures.

These findings demonstrate the lasting impact of BirdieLight's education in empowering young people to protect themselves and make informed, life-saving decisions.

PROGRAM 2: BIRDIEBOX FENTANYL EDUCATION CURRICULUM




BirdieBoxes are a growing part of our educational efforts, providing tailored resources to communities in need. Each BirdieBox includes a digital 4-lesson curriculum, classroom posters, wristbands, stickers, and a How-To Guide for educators. Packed with vital information on fentanyl—including its role in the opioid crisis, the risks of counterfeit pills, and how to recognize them—this flexible resource is designed for digital and physical distribution. Continuously updated and approved by high-school educators, BirdieBoxes ensure lifesaving education reaches schools, even without a BirdieLight representative present.

This year marked an exciting evolution for our BirdieBoxes. In addition to updating our branding, we developed a new middle school version to meet the growing demand for early education on the fentanyl crisis. While this version will soon be available to the public, Mississippi holds an exclusive preview through a pilot program with the Mississippi Public Health Institute.

This partnership brings BirdieBox into middle school classrooms, equipping health teachers with our curriculum to educate students on the risks of fentanyl. Using a train-the-trainer model, the BirdieLight team prepared Mississippi's public health leaders to empower local educators, paving the way for this initiative to expand into high schools.



PROGRAM 3: HARM REDUCTION DISTRIBUTION



Since its inception, our fentanyl test strip program has been a cornerstone of our mission to equip individuals with the tools they need to protect themselves from unintentional fentanyl ingestion. We distribute test strips both online and in person, providing a simple yet effective resource to reduce risk and save lives.



As this map illustrates, in 2024, our reach extended to nearly every corner of the United States. Every point represents a potential life saved—a testament to the impact of harm reduction.

While we're proud of this progress, barriers persist in states where stigma or legal restrictions still limit access to test strips. These hurdles highlight the urgency of our mission. We're driven to break down these barriers, expand availability, and ensure every community has the resources to navigate this crisis confidently.

EXPANSION IN NORTHEAST OHIO

MIDDLE SCHOOL BIRDIEBOX


One of our most exciting upcoming projects is the launch of the Middle School BirdieBox curriculum. Originally created in collaboration with Mississippi's Public Health Initiative. We're now preparing to release a general version of the curriculum for public distribution, ensuring more schools across the country have access to this critical resource.

MEDICAL BIRDIEBOX

BirdieLight is extending its reach by collaborating with medical professionals, equipping them with a specialized BirdieBox to educate and support their patients in fentanyl prevention. This initiative will strengthen the bridge between healthcare and awareness, ensuring that lifesaving conversations happen where they're needed most.


